WORKSHOP | 90 MIN - HALF DAY

For a concrete teaching problem. Participants test an activity, redesign a class component, or make an implementation plan.

SEMINAR | 45 - 90 MIN

For shared exploration. A focused framework, cases, and structured discussion help a group think through a question together.

PRESENTATION | 30 - 60 MIN

For a concise expert perspective. Evidence, examples, and a clear provocation followed by moderated discussion or Q&A.
